CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

The 2007 IEEE International Conference on Robotics and Automation (ICRA'07) will be held in Roma, Italy, from 10 to 14 April 2007. This is the first time that ICRA takes place in a European capital. The conference site is the historic building of the "Angelicum" University, conveniently located in the downtown area. The conference theme is **UBIQUITOUS ROBOTICS**.

TECHNICAL PROGRAM Technical sessions will be held from 11 to 13 April at the conference site, featuring the best 700-750 papers out of the 1800 submitted, 300 of which were accompanied by video clips. The keynote speakers will be: **Alain Berthoz** (Collège de France), **Ken Goldberg** (UC Berkeley), and **Katsushi Ikeuchi** (University of Tokyo). In addition, Tutorials and Workshops will be hosted on 10 and 14 April at the nearby School of Engineering of the University of Roma "La Sapienza" in the area of San Pietro in Vincoli, close to the Colosseum. Panels and Round Tables, the Awards Lunch (open to all registrants), the Young Professional Lunch, and other events will complete the technical program.
