[10-F-01] Move to approve the sponsorship or technical co-sponsorship of all the attached conferences and the budgets of ICRA 2013 and ICRA 2014 (Nikos Papanikolopoulos).

[10-F-02] I move to start the required procedure to transform the Ad Hoc committee on Competitions and Challenges into a Standing Committee under the MAB, and be funded as a RAS budget element (Stefano Stramigioli).

[10-F-04] It is moved that the current Administrative Committee member travel expense allowance for official AdCom meetings be increased by \$200 per AdCom meeting. 5 New Business

There was some discussion of whether AdCom voting should be allowed by teleconference or skype in future. A related issue was whether some committee meetings could be held by teleconference in advance of the conference.

6 Next AdCom Meeting

At IROS 2010, the majority of committee meetings were held after the main conference, to allow AdCom members to attend technical sessions. This is in contrast to previous conferences where committee meetings were held during the conference. There was some discussion of which model works better. President Kosuge conferred with several members of AdCom, and the date of the next AdCom meeting will be announced at a later date. (Update: the Spring 2011 AdCom meeting will be held on April 14 in Shanghai.)
