Teaching English in Rural Africa through Conversational Robotic Agents

NEED – Speaking English means access to information, but many developing countries have limited qualified English teachers.

SOLUTION – We aim to bring English education through *social robots* that are becoming increasingly affordable (Fig.1) and have been proven more effective than onscreen tutors (Fig.2).

PROJECT – We are developing and evaluating a robotic English tutor that will be deployed in an elementary school in Morocco.
