- **8.9 [Motion]** for (1) Past Presidents Expense: To reimburse travel expense and others for Junior and Senior Past Presidents according to the reimbursement rule for ExCom members; (2) Officers Expense: To reimburse travel expense and others for EPSB Chair according to the reimbursement rule for ExCom members; and (3) Expense of Associate VPs and Committee Chairs of Boards: To reimburse travel expense and others for up to three Associate VPs and/or Committee Chairs per each board, and for five Committee Chairs of MAB, according to the reimbursement rule for AdCom members. **8.12 [Motion]** CAB moves to request matching funds up to USD 20,000 to support a 50th Anniversary of Shakey AAAI/RAS financially co-sponsored event at ICRA 2015 to promote interaction between AI and RAS communities to support participation of 1-2 invited speakers,

3-6 speakers to present selected papers from AAAI 2015 with relevance to the RAS community at ICRA 2015, travel scholarships to enable participation of students from AI community to attend ICRA. (Oussama Khatib, CAB)
