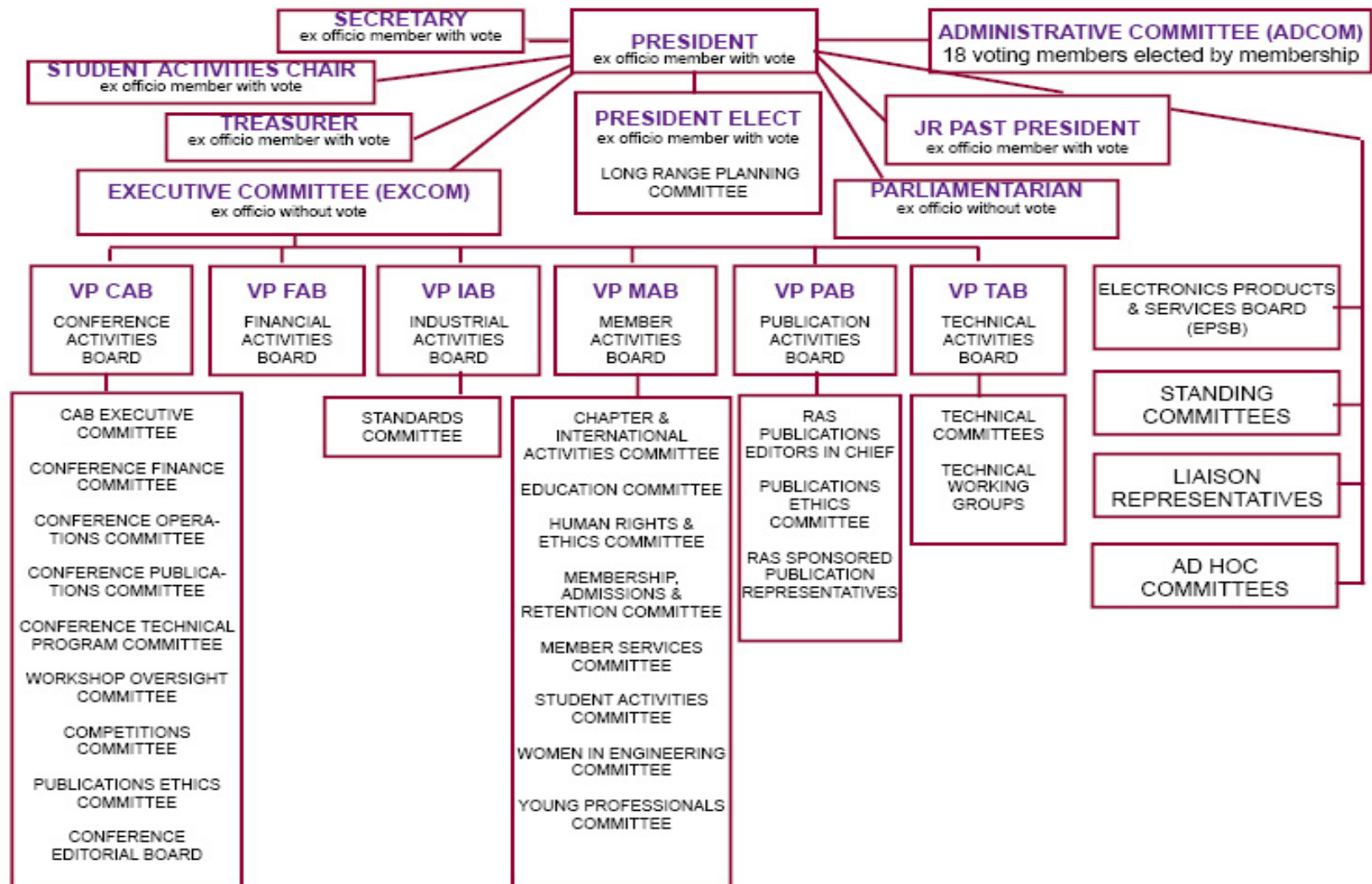

AdCom – Roles & Responsibilities

The AdCom is chaired by the President and it is composed of the following voting members (24): the President, the Junior Past-President, the President-Elect, the Secretary, the Treasurer, the Chair of the Student Activities Standing Committee and the eighteen elected members. The AdCom shall hold at least two meetings each year, one of which is an Annual Meeting (In conjunction with ICRA). The other meeting of the AdCom is usually held in conjunction with IROS.

All RAS meetings will be posted on the website calendar. Unless noted as a “Closed meeting,” **any RAS member may attend**. Chair and location will be listed.
